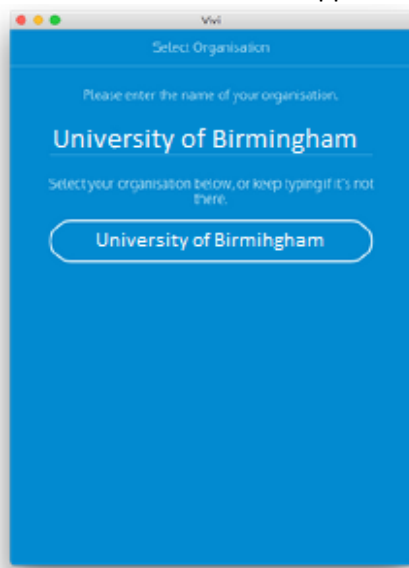
Open your device and connect to the University of Birmingham's Wifi network.

Download the Vivi App on your device. Go to [get.vivi.io](http://get.vivi.io) to download the app onto your device



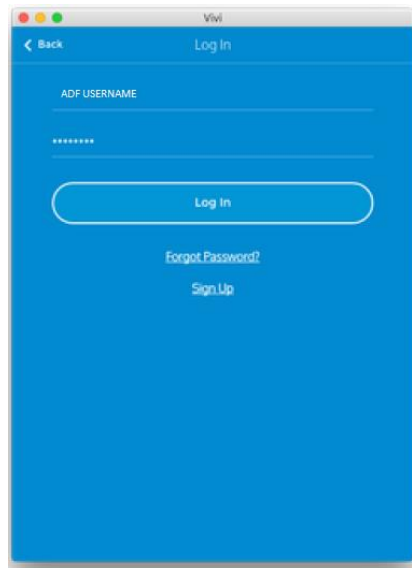

Open Vivi app, and type in the University of Birmingham and then click on the button that appears.



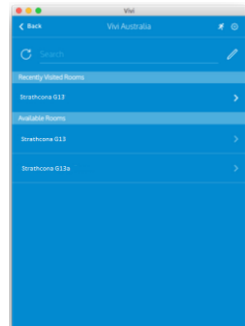

Click Log-in and enter your ADF credentials



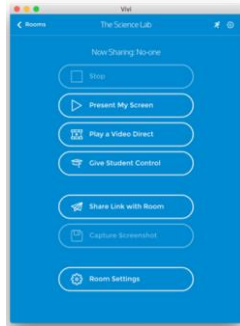

Search and select the room that you want to connect to.

You are now ready to share your screen. Simply press the **Present My Screen** button.



## ABOUT VIVI

Vivi is a wireless presentation system that allows you to mirror your device's screen to the TV in the room and so much more!

It works on laptops, tablets and smart phones across all operating systems.

# VIVI FEATURES



## MOVIE MODE

To improve the quality of video streaming directly from your device, select Movie Mode.

This creates a 2 second delay between your device and the screen, allowing the file to buffer for smooth video play.

## PRESENT SCREEN

Click here to present your screen.

If you use an Apple device, you will need to engage Airplay.

## PLAY A VIDEO DIRECT

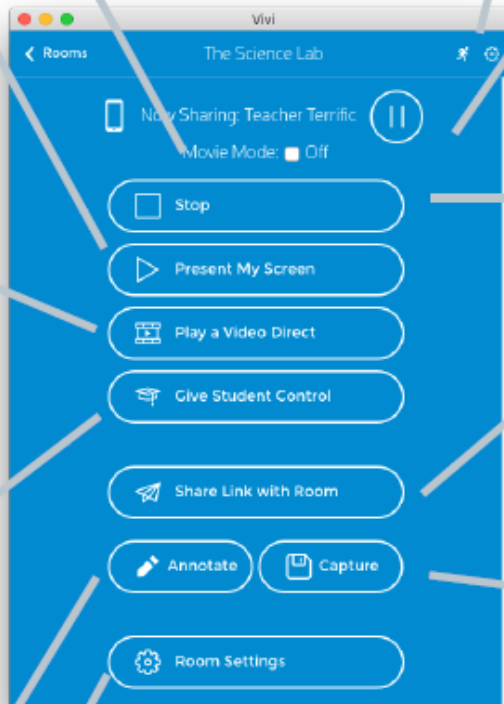
Click here to play a video on the display. You will be able to enter the URL of the video, or select the video from your computer on the next screen.

## GIVE CONTROL TO STUDENTS

Click here to see what students are connected to the room, and which have requested control. To grant access, simply click the student's name.

## ANNOTATE

When you click this button, you or your students will have a screenshot of the screen being presented and access to the annotation tools.



## TRIGGER AN EMERGENCY

If your school uses the emergency broadcast feature, click this running man icon and follow the prompts to activate Vivi's emergency broadcast system.

## PAUSE SCREEN

Click here to pause what you are sharing to the screen. It will leave up a static piece of content, freeing up your device.

## STOP SHARING

Click here to stop sharing your screen, or your student's screen if they are presenting.

## LINK SHARING

Click here, and on the next screen, copy and paste a URL to instantly share content with your class.

## CAPTURE

When you click this button, you or your students will have a screenshot of the screen being presented downloaded to the devices default picture folder.

## ROOM SETTINGS

When you click Room Settings, you will be taken to another screen where you can access the following features:

### Privacy mode:

This allows you to turn off the Capture Screenshot functionality.

### Room codes:

You can add an extra level of privacy to your classroom, by using room codes. Everyone in the classroom must enter a four digit code in order to join the room.

### Open Access:

To let everyone in the class have presentation privileges, turn on open access. You will also need to enable room codes

### Guest Access:

If you have a guest presenter, you can create a code for them to access the screen without the need for them to login.
