Studies have shown that the majority of bisexual people feel that there is no visible bisexual community to connect with. A major aim of Bisexual Visibility Day is to create a safe space for those who identify as bisexual, so they know they are neither alone, nor different.

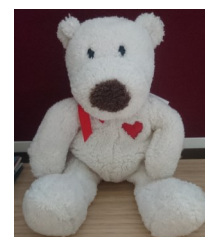
We urge Theresa May to issue an official apology and make amendments to all those who were unjustly punished under Britain's anti-gay laws.
