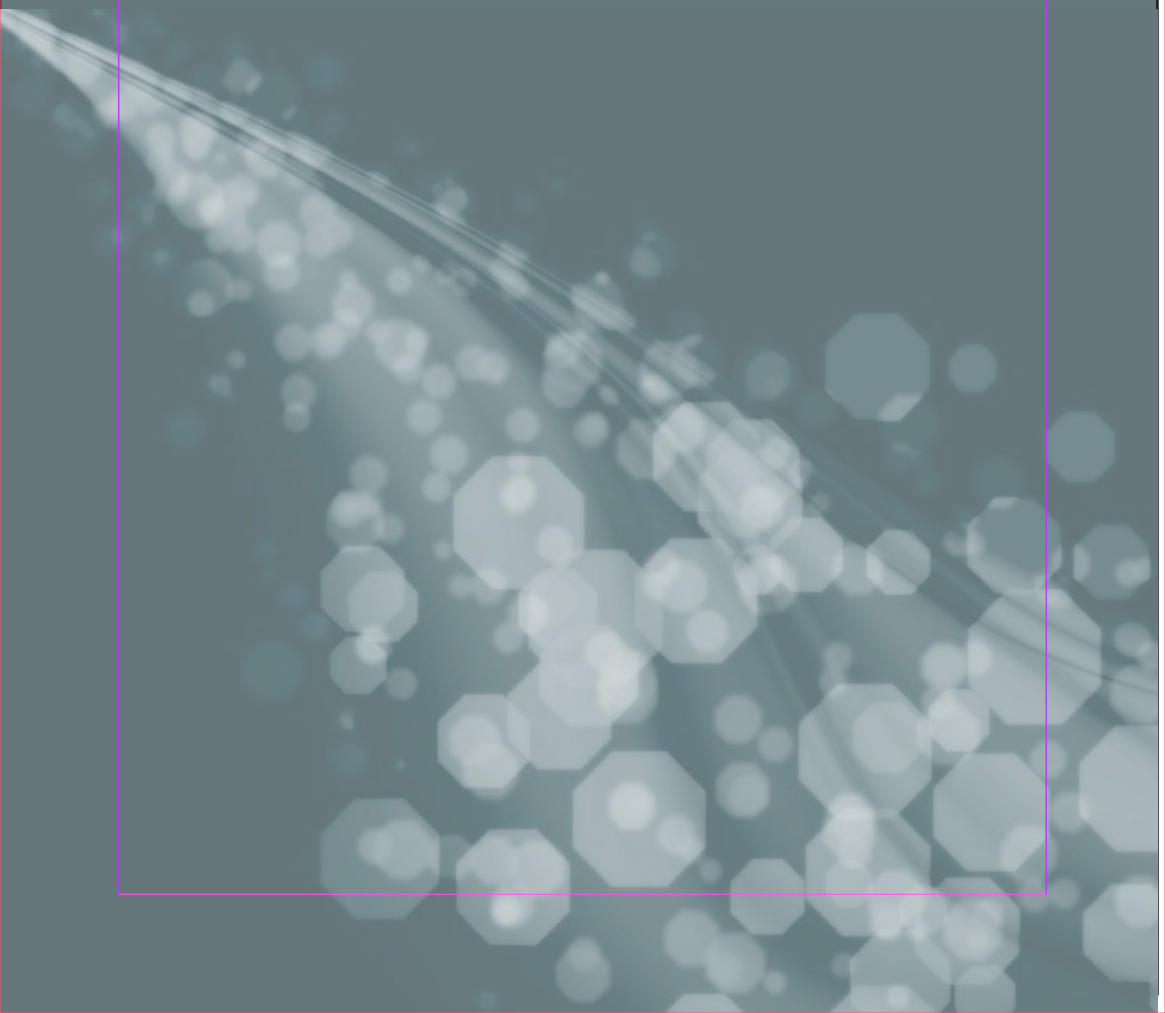

WHO WE ARE

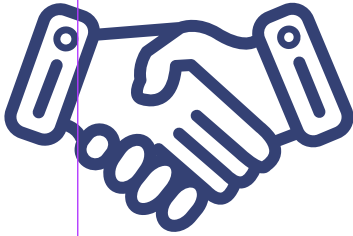
Safety Services are part of the University's Workplace Wellbeing Team and provides competent health and safety advice to all areas of the University. It also designs and delivers centrally provided health and safety and fire safety training required by both Health and Safety and Fire Safety Legislation.



WHAT SERVICES WE PROVIDE

- Policy, Procedure and Guidance development and review
- Supporting the University's health and safety consultation arrangements by attending committees/groups and providing reports
- Advising on both general health and safety and specialist risks associated with the University's work and research
- Assisting the University with its statutory duties including liaising with Enforcing Authorities
- Development and provision of specialist services to internal and external bodies
- Development, promotion and implementation of safety related initiatives
- Development and provision of communication systems and events/campaigns for communicating the "safety message"
- Development and provision of centrally provided safety training including fire
- Management of the University's accident and incident reporting procedure including supporting and assisting with the investigation of serious incidents, identification and analysis of trends
- Supporting the University's governance and assurance processes by providing assistance with inspections, audits and development of and monitoring of action plans

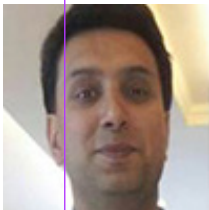

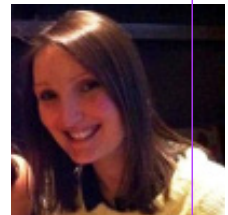
