How our pathways work:

- **MSc International Accounting and Finance** – 12 month programme with no additional tuition/ACCA examinations
- **MSc International Accounting and Finance (Pathway 2)** – 12 month programme, with additional tuition and two professional ACCA exams completed towards your ACCA Professional Qualification – additional fees apply
- **MSc International Accounting and Finance (Pathway 3)** – 16 month programme, with additional tuition and four ACCA professional exams taken to complete your ACCA Professional Qualification – additional fees apply

MSc International Accounting and Finance Pathway 2

As well as taking the above MSc, you will be able to take additional tuition and exams with our partners, Kaplan Financial, towards your ACCA Professional Qualification. This 12 month full time programme will see you complete two professional level exams with the ACCA. Students will have the opportunity to take:

- Advanced Performance Management
- Advanced Financial Management

As well as taking the above MSc, you will be able to take additional tuition and exams with our partners, Kaplan Financial. You will be able to complete your ACCA Professional Qualification on this 16 month long programme, by completing the four ACCA papers that are required for this advanced qualification: Students will have the opportunity to take:

- Advanced Financial Management
- Strategic Business Reporting
- Strategic Business Leader
