### MSc Management

Our MSc Management programmes introduce students to advanced management concepts through a combination of core foundation subjects and specialist pathway modules. Open to graduates from a business background, this suite of programmes will build on your existing skills and knowledge, preparing you for your future career in a variety of diverse and exciting areas. We offer students the opportunity to study on either our general pathway or one of our specialist pathways, enabling you to tailor your experience to your own career goals.

If you continue on our general pathway, you will take eight core modules and submit a research dissertation. You will also choose five optional modules.



### **MSc Management (Entrepreneurship and Innovation)**

Entrepreneurship is at the heart of successful business, driving forward innovation and constantly pursuing new achievements and ambitions. This specialist programme offers you an excellent platform into your chosen career in industry, including consulting, research and policymaking as well as exploring opportunities to start your own business.

### **MSc Management (Organisational Leadership and Change)**

Every organisation demands high-level management in order to run smoothly and efficiently. Successful change management requires strong leadership to drive through organisational change. This course prepares students for a career in the ever-changing arena of organisational leadership, building on the skills you gained in your undergraduate studies.

You will take three core modules, three specialist pathway modules and submit a research dissertation. You will also choose two optional modules

### **MSc Management (Strategy)**

Strategic management and leadership are what drive successful companies forward, shaping their decision-making and helping them achieve their ambitions. Without a strong strategic plan, organisations cannot function at a competitive level, and this degree will prepare you to be a key player in your company's success.

### **MSc Management (Operations)**

Every organisation demands high-level management in order to run smoothly and efficiently. Operations management is all about how to organise the production and delivery of products and services. More precisely, operations management is a combination of supply chain management and logistics. Operations management is deliver-focused, ensuring that an organisation successfully turns input into output with efficiency.
